This report shows an \$85.7 million excess of revenues over expenses for Oregon Athletics in FY14. Athletic revenues include in-kind facility gifts of \$95M, \$740k of camp revenues in excess of camp expenses which is retained by our various sports camps, and arena bond reserve revenue (non-spendable) of \$550K. The items above total \$96.3M and do not represent a spendable cash in-flow to the Department of Athletics during FY2013-14.

Additionally, the \$110.4M in expenses shown on this report include non-capitalized furniture, fixture and equipment gifted to the athletic department totaling \$11M.

Excluding the in-kind facility gifts and the other items noted above, FY14 athletics revenues totaled \$99.1M and FY14 athletics expenses totaled \$98.8M.
