Oregon's First Varsity Soccer Team (1980)

1980 & 1981: The First Varsity Teams

Oregon women's soccer can trace its roots to the spring of 1980, when the University announced that it was adding women's soccer as a varsity sport. The Ducks competed in the Northwest Collegiate Soccer Conference (NWCSC) along with teams from Oregon State, Washington, Washington State, Lewis & Clark, Puget Sound, Western Washington and Whitman. Most home games were contested at Autzen Stadium, though other fields throughout Eugene were also used. Under coach John Feeney, the Ducks won the NWCSC with a 9-1-3 record and went 13-1-3 overall.

Forward Michele Potestio scored a school-record 22 goals and was named a second team All-American by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA).

In the spring of 1981, amid a grave budget crisis, the University announced it was dropping women's soccer, along with baseball, women's golf and men's gymnastics, from varsity status.

New head coach Manfred Tschan, who was Oregon's assistant coach for the 1980 season, appealed to the athletic department to allow women's soccer to retain its varsity status for the fall of 1981. His appeal was based on the fact that the AIAW had earlier agreed to extend Oregon an invitation to the 1981 national tournament under three conditions, one of which was that the team was considered a varsity sport by the University. In other words, the AIAW would not allow any club teams at its national championship.

With a compelling case to allow the women's soccer team the opportunity to compete for a national championship, in addition to freshmen who were recruited the previous fall who were already receiving scholarship aid, the athletic department consented to keep women's soccer on its varsity rolls for one more season. But there were conditions. Other than the freshmen on scholarship, the program would receive no support of any kind from the department; it would be treated like a club sport. Players and coaches had to adhere to University and NCAA rules. And the varsity agreement would end following the 1981 season.

In spite of the conditions, Oregon defended its NWCSC title with an undefeated 8-0-2 record to earn an invitation to the 1981 12-team AIAW national tournament in Chapel Hill, N.C.

There, the Ducks lost 3-1 in overtime to No. 2 Connecticut, defeated Massachusetts 1-0 and lost the consolation final to Harvard 4-3 in overtime. Oregon finished the season 13-2-3 and ranked fifth nationally. Defender Meg Metz earned NSCAA first team All-America honors, while Potestio was a third-team All-America selection.

In the fall of 2007, Athletic Director Pat Kilkenny officially granted varsity status to the 1981 season and formally recognized the 1980 team as Oregon's first varsity squad.

"I am very pleased to announce the formal recognition of the 1980 and 1981 varsity women's soccer teams and grant official letterman status to the 29 women who represented the University of Oregon so well on the field during those two seasons," said Kilkenny.

After the 1981 season, women's soccer at Oregon existed as a club sport until 1996.
